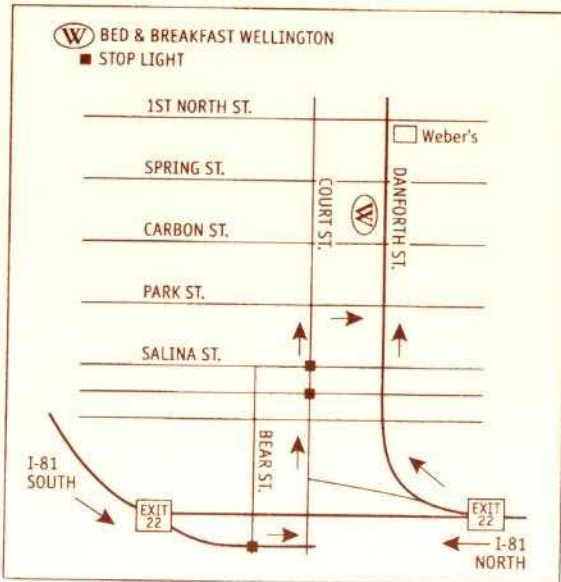
Directions

Heading North on I-81

While heading North on I-81, take Exit 22, Court Street (just past 85 mile marker). At the exit ramp bear right. You are now on Danforth St. Our B&B is 5 blocks up the hill on the left. It is a brown brick and cream stucco house. The Franciscan Friary is across the street.

From the Thruway (Interstate 90) to I-81 South

Use Exit 36 (Airport exit) and proceed south on I-81. Take Exit 22, Bear St. Continue one block past the first light (Bear Street) to Court St. Turn left at Court St. and proceed 3 1/2 blocks to Park Street. Turn right on Park St. and proceed one block to Danforth St. Turn left on Danforth St. and go two blocks. The house is a brown and cream stucco and brick house on the left. Our address is 707 Danforth Street.

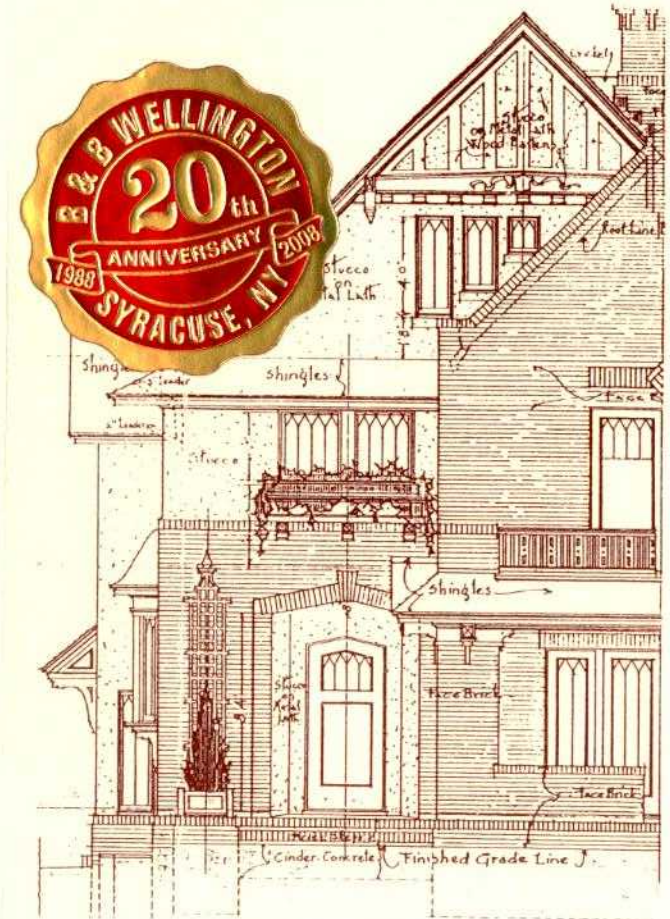

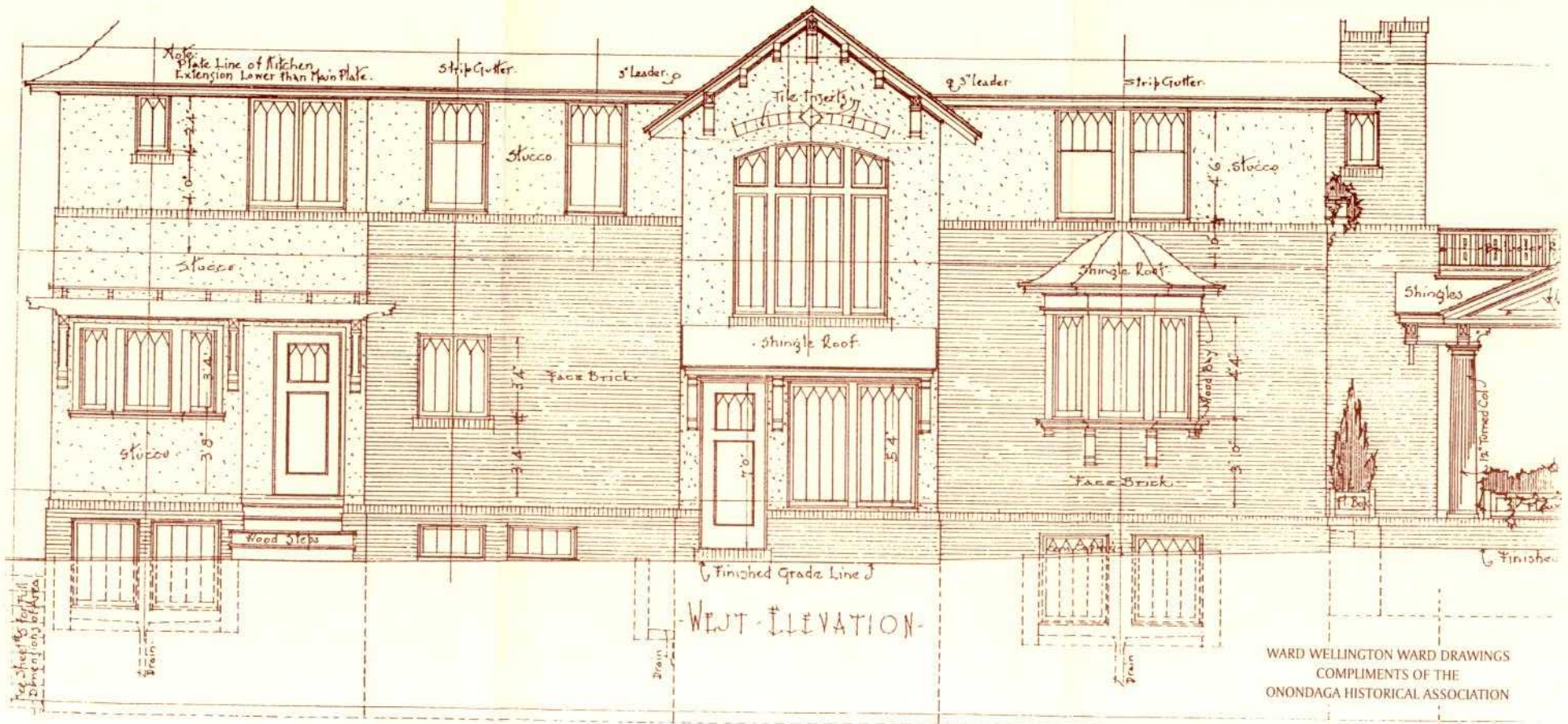
